

**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ROAD SERVICE AREA  
RESOLUTION 2008-06**

**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING ACCEPTANCE OF A STATE LEGISLATIVE  
GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,400,000 FOR BOROUGH-WIDE ROAD  
IMPROVEMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 221, which appropriated \$8.4 million to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for borough-wide road improvement projects, was passed by the state legislature and signed by the governor in May 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, these are five-year grant funds and will expire June 30, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds may be appropriated to roads designated by Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of these funds are to be allocated to the Keystone Drive Project that the RSA Board approved via RSA Resolution 2008-04.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
ROAD SERVICE AREA BOARD:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Road Service Area Board recommends the Mayor accept the grant from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$8,400,000 for KPB road improvements.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
