KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH **ORDINANCE 2008-19-12**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$40,000 FOR THE PURCHASE AND UPGRADE OF A WATER TANKER BY THE KACHEMAK EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, the Kachemak Emergency Service Area (KESA) board has identified the need for a water tanker as part of its long-term capital plan; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Valdez has a 1980 4,000 gallon water tanker which it has identified as surplus and scheduled for sealed bid auction on August 7, 2008; and
- WHEREAS, a used water tanker could meet the needs of the service area residents depending on its condition and cost; and
- WHEREAS, KESA personnel are currently examining the tanker to determine if it meets their needs; and
- WHEREAS, the KESA board at its July 10, 2008, meeting recommended that up to \$40,000 be made available from its KESA Capital Project Fund fund balance for the acquisition of the tanker and cost necessary to bring the tanker up to KESA standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the amount of \$40,000 is hereby appropriated from the KESA Capital Project Fund fund balance to KESA Capital Project Fund account number 446.51810.09582.48514 for purchase of the 1980 4,000 gallon water tanker.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
