RE: Amendment to Ordinance 2008-19-21, Authorizing the Purchase of Land from R. Dan Green Adjacent to Heritage Place.

Section 7 of this ordinance erroneously authorizes the mayor to pay the sum of \$355,500 to **Mary L. Green** and does not identify the transferee of the borough property. The funds are to be paid to **R. Dan Green** and the borough property is to be transferred to **Mary Green**. The administration requests that the following amendments be made to correct Section 7:

SECTION 7. That upon completion of the resubdivision of Lots 9-16, Block 1, Green Estates Subdivision, Plat 79-62, and vacation of Brooks Circle right-of-way as described above in Section 1, the mayor is authorized to pay the sum of \$355,500 to ~~Mary L.~~ **R. Dan** Green and to transfer property identified as Lot 6-A Mackey Lake Station Subdivision, according to plat no. 93-27, Kenai Recording District containing 2.92 acres with a value of \$24,500 **to Mary L. Green.**
