## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2008-19-23

## AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$550,000 FROM THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECT FUND FOR PURCHASE OF A NEW TYPE A FIRE ENGINE

- WHEREAS, the Nikiski Fire Service Area Board (the board) identified the need to replace two type A fire engines that are approximately 25 years old; and
- WHEREAS, the service area received a grant from the State of Alaska in the amount of \$550,000, which was appropriated through Ordinance 2008-19-03, for the replacement of one of the fire engines; and
- WHEREAS, at its September 10, 2008, meeting, the board approved the use of \$550,000 from the Nikiski Fire Service Area Capital Project Fund, fund balance for the purchase of a second fire engine; and
- WHEREAS, the service area board has indicated that once the new fire engines are received, the older fire engines will be sent to Tyonek and Beluga to supplement their current equipment;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That \$550,000 is appropriated from the Nikiski Fire Service Area Capital Project Fund, fund balance to account number 441.51111.9FENG.48514 for the purchase of a new type A fire engine.
- **SECTION 2** That the appropriation of \$175,000 approved in the capital projects list for the purchase of an ambulance be hereby revoked and the funds reverted to the capital project fund account for Nikiski Fire Service Area.
- **SECTION 3.** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
