SUBJECT: Platting Code Consistency

It has been brought to the RSA Board's attention that the borough's platting code in KPB 20.20 allows for right-of-ways less then 60 feet in width. The Road Service Area code in KPB 14.06.100 requires a minimum 60 foot right-of – way width for roads to be certified for maintenance. This width insures adequate room for snow storage, drainage, and utility installation. The perceived inconsistency between the two code sections has generated some confusion among applicants for road maintenance certification.

At its August meeting, the RSA board considered whether or not 60 feet was actually necessary for maintenance or if this minimum width could be reduced in the interest of consistency with the platting code. The Board concurred with staff comments that a reduction in the right-of-way width would generally be problematic for maintenance operations.

On behalf of the RSA Board I am requesting that the Planning Department review its provision for right-of-ways less than 60 feet, and if reasonable initiate a code change that would reflect a requirement for right-of-ways to have a minimum width of 60 feet.
