## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2008-19-39

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF LOT 12, K-B SUBDIVISION PART 4, KRD 85-34, FOR EXPANSION OF THE POPPY LANE BOROUGH MAINTENANCE YARD AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE ACQUISITION

- **WHEREAS**, the subject 0.92 acre parcel abuts the Poppy Lane Maintenance property immediately north of the entrance to the maintenance garage; and
- WHEREAS, the subject parcel is vacant with a cleared gravel pad; and
- WHEREAS, the subject parcel is immediately useful to maintenance operations for improving traffic flow, equipment storage, snow storage and drainage; and
- WHEREAS, the subject parcel is strategically located to address future facility needs; and
- WHEREAS, the owner has agreed to sell the .92 acre Lot 12 for the fair market value of \$55,000; and
- WHEREAS, the KPB Planning Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting of January 26, 2009 recommended enactment by unanimous consent;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the purchase Lot 12, Block 4, K-B Subdivision, Part 4, according to Plat No. 85-34, Kenai Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska containing .92 acres more or less, from Mr. Beau M. Clark, is in the best interests of the borough.
- **SECTION 2.** That the terms and conditions substantially in the form of the Purchase Agreement accompanying this ordinance are hereby approved. The purchase price shall be \$55,000 and the borough's share of the closing costs shall not exceed \$2,500.
- **SECTION 3.** That this acquisition is for the purpose of supporting operations and development of the borough's maintenance facility.

- **SECTION 4.** That the proposed classification of this land is government.
- **SECTION 5.** That the mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to purchase the real property described in Section 1 in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in this ordinance and the accompanying Purchase Agreement and consistent with applicable provisions of KPB Chapter 17.10.
- **SECTION 6.** That \$57,500 is appropriated from the Land Trust Fund, fund balance to account 250.21210.00000.43011 for expenditures associated with this acquisition
- **SECTION 7.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
