KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2008-19-50

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING TWO GRANTS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,716.56 FOR PROJECTS UNDER THE FY2007 COASTAL IMPACT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Coastal Impact Assistance Program (CIAP) was established under Section 384 of the Energy Act of 2005 and authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to disburse funds to Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas producing states; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of the CIAP is to provide funding through a non-competitive grant process to oil and gas producing states to mitigate the effects of offshore oil and gas activities; and
- WHEREAS, eligible recipients of CIAP funds in Alaska are those communities that participate in the Alaska Coastal Management Program, which includes the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- WHEREAS, eligible recipients are required to submit a list of approved projects to the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, and upon its approval the projects are forwarded to the U.S. Minerals Management Service for final approval; and
- WHEREAS, the Assembly finds it is in the best interest of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to participate in the Coastal Impact Assistance Program; and
- WHEREAS, four worthy projects throughout the Peninsula were approved through adoption of KPB Resolution 2007-032; and
- WHEREAS, through adoption of Resolution 2008-17 a fifth project was added to the Assembly-approved list of CIAP projects; and
- WHEREAS, most of the Assembly-approved projects have also been approved by the State and the U.S. Department of Interior, Minerals Management Service, for funding under CIAP; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough has received notice of grant award for two of the five approved projects: the Kasilof Personal Use Fisheries Habitat Protection project in the amount of \$6,074.34 and CIAP Planning and Administration in the amount of \$6,642.22; and

WHEREAS, as the Planning and Administration grant expires June 30, 2009, and the Kasilof Personal Fisheries grant expires September 30, 2009, a shortened hearing date is requested to allow sufficient time to enter into the grant agreement and file reports in a timely manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI **PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept the above-described grants from the U.S. Department of Interior, Minerals Management Service, in the amount of \$12,716.56 through its FY2007 Coastal Impact Assistance Program, and is authorized to execute grant agreements and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grants and fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- SECTION 2. That grant funds totaling \$12,716.56 are hereby appropriated to the following account numbers for the purpose of completing two of the projects approved in KPB **Resolution 2007-032:**
