SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 2008-19-54 (Substitute): Accepting and appropriating \$83,080 from the U.S. Department of Interior for the Crooked Creek Recreation Area Riverbank Restoration Project under the Coastal Impact Assistance Program

Ordinance 2008-19-54 was introduced on April 21, 2009. This ordinance accepts \$83,080 from the U.S. Department of Interior for riverbank restoration at the Crooked Creek recreational area. Subsequent to introduction of Ordinance 2008-19-54, another notice of award was received from the Department of Interior for a second project in the Crooked Creek area. The second award is for \$15,000 to provide riverbank restoration and habitat protection as part of the Kenai Watershed Forum's restoration project at Crooked Creek near Johnson Lake Road and the Sterling Highway. Because of the similarities between the two grants, the administration would like to offer a substitute ordinance that accepts and appropriates both grants. The total amount appropriated would be \$98,080. A copy of the proposed substitute ordinance is attached.
