- WHEREAS, Bear Creek Fire Service Area ("Service Area") applied for a grant under the 2009 Volunteer Fire Assistance ("VFA") grant program administered by the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry; and
- WHEREAS, notice was received that a VFA grant in the amount of \$8,998.20 has been awarded to the Service Area for the purchase of firefighting equipment; and

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept a Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant from the Department of Natural Resources on behalf of Bear Creek Fire Service Area and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grants and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$8,998.20 are appropriated to the following Service Area account: 207.51210.OVFA1.48514 Firefighting Equipment
- **SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
