## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2009-19-24

## AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$30,000 IN SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING TO COVER THE COST OF VEHICLE MAINTENANCE AND INDIVIDUAL PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS FOR THE ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, a mechanical review by the Central Emergency Services mechanic on all of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area (Service Area) response vehicles revealed a number of deficiencies that need to be addressed; and
- WHEREAS, the FY2010 Service Area budget does not have sufficient funding to repair the deficiencies that were identified on the response vehicles; and
- WHEREAS, an internal protocol of conducting individual physical examinations has been overlooked and must be completed for all core volunteers; and
- WHEREAS, the FY2010 Service Area budget does not have sufficient funding to conduct physicals for the Service Area core volunteers; and
- WHEREAS, at its November 23, 2009, meeting, the Service Area Board of Directors authorized the appropriation of \$15,000 for costs associated with repairing the Service Area's vehicles and \$15,000 for the cost of individual physical examinations for the Service Area core volunteers;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

**SECTION 1.** That \$30,000 is appropriated from the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area, Fund Balance to the following accounts:

\$15,000 to account 209.51410.00000.43750, vehicle maintenance

\$15,000 to account 209.51410.00000.43014, physical examinations

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
