## AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$55,000 FOR RIVERBANK RESTORATION AT THE RIVER CENTER

- WHEREAS, the Donald E. Gilman River Center ("River Center") has approximately 500 linear feet of river frontage that has been developed and managed for a seasonal use fishery; and
- WHEREAS, due to two high water events in 2009, the existing spruce tree revetment and riparian vegetation along the river were damaged by the users of the fishery; and
- WHEREAS, it is estimated that maintenance costs necessary to repair the riverbank to prevent further erosion and damage will be approximately \$55,000; and
- WHEREAS, a transfer from the borough's general fund is needed to provide the funding necessary for these repairs; and
- WHEREAS, because these repairs must be undertaken during low water, shortened hearing is being requested, allowing for the repairs to be started in June;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That \$55,000 is appropriated from the borough's general fund, fund balance to account 100.94910.00000.50409, transfer to the Resource Management Capital Project Fund.
- **SECTION 2.** That \$55,000 is appropriated in the Resource Management Capital Project Fund to account from the borough's general fund, fund balance to account 407.19010.RVRBK.499999, riverbank restoration.
- **SECTION 3.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
