**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2009-19-34**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$55,000 FOR RIVERBANK RESTORATION AT
THE RIVER CENTER**

WHEREAS, the Donald E. Gilman River Center (“River Center”) has approximately 500 linear feet of river frontage that has been developed and managed for a seasonal use fishery; and

WHEREAS, due to two high water events in 2009, the existing spruce tree revetment and riparian vegetation along the river were damaged by the users of the fishery; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that maintenance costs necessary to repair the riverbank to prevent further erosion and damage will be approximately \$55,000; and

WHEREAS, a transfer from the borough’s general fund is needed to provide the funding necessary for these repairs; and

WHEREAS, because these repairs must be undertaken during low water, shortened hearing is being requested, allowing for the repairs to be started in June;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$55,000 is appropriated from the borough’s general fund, fund balance to account 100.94910.00000.50409, transfer to the Resource Management Capital Project Fund.


SECTION 2. That \$55,000 is appropriated in the Resource Management Capital Project Fund to account from the borough’s general fund, fund balance to account 407.19010.RVRBK.499999, riverbank restoration.

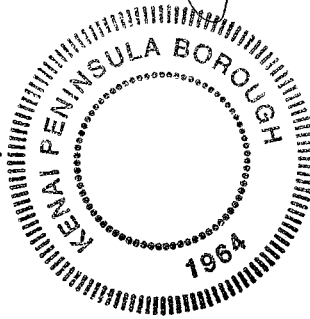
SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
