RE: Employer Relief Funding - PERS ER 180

During the 2009 legislative session, House Bill 81 (HB81) passed providing funding relief for PERS employer contributions for Fiscal Year 2010 (FY10). HB81, Section 23 (b) read as follows:

(b) The sum of \$107,953,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Administration for deposit in the defined benefit plan account in the public employees' retirement system as an additional state contribution under AS 39.35.280 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.

The FY10 Alaska Retirement Management Board adopted rate was 27.65 percent, with HB81 providing a relief rate of 5.65 percent for each FY10 employer payroll. Relief funding was applied with the processing of each employer payroll with payroll end dates between July 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010, and received by the Division by July 31, 2010. All such payrolls have been processed, and we have trued-up your account by making an adjusting entry.

Enclosed is a report detailing the actuals for the Employer Relief Funding allocated for fiscal year 2010 payrolls. This is your final statement for FY10.
