SUBJECT: Ordinance 2010-07, amending KPB 4.30.060 to prohibit a person from serving simultaneously as a member of the assembly and member of a city council within the borough

I would like to amend this ordinance to also prohibit city mayors from serving on the assembly. At this time, the area of the borough outside the cities has a higher population than the areas inside the cities. All five first class and home rule cities are in separate assembly districts. If five of the nine assembly seats were held by city mayors and council members, because they have fiducial duties to the cities, this would skew the representation of the borough residents inside and outside cities.

➤ Amend the title as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 4.30.060 TO PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM SERVING SIMULTANEOUSLY AS A MEMBER OF THE ASSEMBLY AND MEMBER OF A CITY COUNCIL OR MAYOR WITHIN THE BOROUGH

➤ Amend Section 1 as follows:

SECTION 1. That KPB 4.30.060 is hereby amended as follows:

4.30.060. Prohibitions.

- A. A person may not serve simultaneously as mayor and as a member of the assembly, as mayor and a member of the school board, [OR] as a member of the assembly and member of the school board, or as a member of the assembly and a member of the city council or the mayor of any incorporated city within the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
- B. No elected official of the borough may hold any other compensated borough office or borough employment, or elected position in the state or federal government while in office.
