The Alaska Department Natural Resources, Division of Forestry Volunteer Fire Assistance Program (VFA) provides assistance in training, equipment purchases and prevention activities. The VFA program may be used for both wildland and structure protection needs. The assistance is provided to increase firefighter safety, improve the fire fighting capabilities of rural volunteer fire departments, and enhance protection in the urban-wildland interface.

KESA applied for and has received an award notice in the amount of \$10,000 for the purpose of purchasing minor firefighting equipment. The VFA program requires 10% matching funds; KESA will meet the 10% match requirement through expenditures made from its operating budget prior to December 31, 2010.
