**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2010-19-07**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$50,000 FROM THE STATE
OF ALASKA TO CENTRAL EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA
FOR OFF ROAD VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the Central Emergency Service Area ("Service Area") requested funding to purchase two all-terrain vehicles, two snow machines and a transport trailer in the borough's 2010 legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 230, which appropriated funding to the borough for this project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor on June 04, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the borough has received notice from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded to the borough in the amount of \$50,000 for the Service Area; and

WHEREAS, off road vehicles provide logistical means of transport for emergency responders to reach the injured in inaccessible areas; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on June 17, 2010, the Service Area Board unanimously passed a motion recommending grant acceptance; and

WHEREAS, the performance period for the state legislative grant is from July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2015, and does not require any matching funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$50,000 for off road vehicles and trailer equipment for the Central Emergency Service Area, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$50,000 are appropriated to 443.51610.11033.49999.


SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

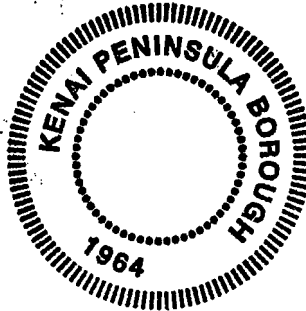
SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
