KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2010-19-09

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$73,000 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO PURCHASE AN AMBULANCE FOR THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, the Nikiski Fire Service Area Board ("Service Area Board") requested funding to purchase an ambulance in the Borough's 2010 legislative priorities; and
- WHEREAS, the ambulance will replace an aging unit with an advance life support ambulance; and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill 230, which appropriated funding to the borough for this project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor on June 04, 2010; and
- WHEREAS, the borough has received notice from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded to the borough in the amount of \$73,000 for the Service Area; and
- WHEREAS, the service area has funds available in the 2010/2011 capital projects account to complete the purchase of the ambulance in the amount of \$185,000; and
- WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on June 22, 2010, the Service Area Board unanimously passed a motion recommending grant acceptance; and
- WHEREAS, the performance period for the state legislative grant is from July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2015, and does not require any matching funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$73,000 for an ambulance for the Nikiski Fire Service Area, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That grant funds in the amount of \$73,000 are appropriated to 441.51110.11034.49999.

SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
