KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2010-19-11

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$5,000,000 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO THE BOROUGH ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

- WHEREAS, the road service area ("RSA") board has compiled a list of road capital improvement projects that qualify for state funding; and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill 230, which appropriated funding to the borough for road improvements, was passed by the state legislature and signed by the governor on June 4, 2010; and
- WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development that a legislative grant has been awarded to the borough in the amount of \$5,000,000 to the road service area for road improvements; and
- WHEREAS, at its regular meeting of June 15, 2010, the service area board of directors passed RSA Resolution 2010-07 recommending grant acceptance; and
- WHEREAS, the performance period for the state legislative grant is from July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2015, and does not require any matching funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to accept, on behalf of the road service area, a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$5,000,000 for road improvements, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That acceptance of the above grant is subject to the requirement that the award of a contract or contracts for each project shall be submitted to the assembly for approval by resolution. No contract may be awarded until after the grant agreement for these funds has been executed by the borough and the state.

- SECTION 3. That grant funds in the amount of \$5,000,000 are hereby appropriated to 434.33950.11252.49999.
- SECTION 4. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
