**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2010-19-20**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$160,000 FROM THE SCHOOL REVENUE
CAPITAL PROJECT FUND FOR INSTALLATION OF SECURITY CAMERAS AT
VARIOUS SCHOOL FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, there has been a noticeable increase in vandalism at borough schools in the last few years; and

WHEREAS, the borough has included funding for security cameras as part of its legislative priorities request the past few years and has received funding totaling \$40,000; and

WHEREAS, the borough has seen a decrease in vandalism where security cameras have been installed using those funds; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of providing security cameras at the various borough schools is in excess of \$2,000,000; and


WHEREAS, the School Revenue Capital Project Fund has \$160,000 that is currently available for appropriation to support the purchase and installation of security cameras;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$160,000 is appropriated from the School Revenue Capital Project Fund, fund balance, to account 400.78050.11SEC.49999, security camera improvements.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.


