## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2010-19-22

## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$1,500,000 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA FOR THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA STATION TWO CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

- WHEREAS, the Nikiski Fire Service Area ("Service Area") requested funding for the fire station two construction; and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill 230, which appropriated funding to the borough for this project, was passed by the State Legislature and signed by the Governor on June 4, 2010; and
- WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development ("DCCED") that a legislative grant has been awarded to the borough in the amount of \$1,500,000 for the Service Area; and
- WHEREAS, at the regular meeting on June 22, 2010, the Service Area Board of Directors unanimously passed a motion recommending grant acceptance; and
- WHEREAS, the performance period for the state legislative grant is from April 19, 2010, through June 30, 2015, and does not require matching funds; and
- WHEREAS, the DCCED grant award will replace local funds that were appropriated to the fire station and boat storage facility construction projects; and
- WHEREAS, the DCCED grant award may also be used for design, site preparation and construction of the fire personnel training field located at fire station two;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a grant from the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development in the amount of \$1,500,000 for the Nikiski Fire Service Area station two construction projects, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- SECTION 2. That grant funds in the amount of \$1,500,000 are appropriated to 441.51110.11250.49999, the project account.

**SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
