**SUBJECT:** Ordinance 2010-19-<sup>25</sup> Accepting and appropriating \$326,617 from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management to support the activities of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Local Emergency Planning Committee.

The Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) identified the lack of a regional, integrated plan to respond to a mass casualty event along with a lack of a coordinated plan to identify alternative care facilities in the event of a mass casualty incident or damage to regional hospitals. A subcommittee was appointed to address these issues and a grant application was made to support this effort.

The Alaska Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management (ADHS&EM) has awarded \$326,617 to the Kenai Peninsula Borough to support development of a mass casualty/alternative care facility plan and to purchase equipment to support a response to this type of incident.

Upon enactment, the Emergency Management Coordinator will be the project manager for this grant in support of the LEPC committee's efforts.

The award letter and project detail will be provided at the introduction scheduled October 26, 2010.
