KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 2009-018

A RESOLUTION APPROVING PROJECTS FOR COASTAL IMPACT ASSISTANCE GRANT FUNDS

- WHEREAS, a Coastal Impact Assistance Program (CIAP) was reauthorized by Congress in the Energy Policy Act and signed into law by President Bush in 2005; and
- WHEREAS, the purpose of the CIAP is to share Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) lease revenue with oil and gas producing states and their coastal political subdivisions based upon allocation formulas prescribed by the Act or the purpose of mitigating the effects of offshore oil and gas development; and
- WHEREAS, eligible recipients of CIAP funds in Alaska are those coastal political subdivisions that participate in the Alaska Coastal Management Program, which includes the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- WHEREAS, eligible boroughs and coastal districts are required to submit a list of approved projects to the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Coastal and Ocean Management; and
- WHEREAS, the federal government has allocated additional funds to the program and the State Alaska is required to share OCS lease revenue with coastal political subdivisions such as the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- WHEREAS, the assembly previously approved CIAP projects for federal funding in Resolution 2007-032 and;
- WHEREAS, the assembly finds it is in the best interest of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to continue participation in the CIAP;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough projects shown in the document titled "Kenai Peninsula Borough, 2009 - 2010 Coastal Impact Assistance Program," incorporated herein by reference, are hereby established as the approved projects for CIAP funding.

SECTION 2. That a copy of this resolution shall be provided to the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, Division of Coastal and Ocean Management.

SECTION 3. This resolution becomes effective immediately upon its adoption.
