**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$95,272 FROM THE U.S.  
DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR FOR THE HABITAT PROTECTION EDUCATION  
AND CODE REVISION PROJECT UNDER THE COASTAL IMPACT ASSISTANCE  
PROGRAM**

1   **WHEREAS,** the Coastal Impact Assistance Program (CIAP) was established under Section 384  
2                   of the Energy Act of 2005 and authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to disburse  
3                   funds to Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas producing states; and

4   **WHEREAS,** the purpose of the CIAP is to provide funding through a non-competitive grant  
5                   process to oil and gas producing states to mitigate the effects of offshore oil and  
6                   gas activities; and

7   **WHEREAS,** eligible recipients of CIAP funds in Alaska are those communities that participate  
8                   in the Alaska Coastal Management Program, which includes the Kenai Peninsula  
9                   Borough; and

10   **WHEREAS,** eligible recipients are required to submit a list of approved projects to the Alaska  
11                   Department of Natural Resources, and upon their approval the projects are  
12                   forwarded to the U.S. Minerals Management Service, henceforth known as the  
13                   Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation and Enforcement (BOEMRE)  
14                   for final approval; and

15   **WHEREAS,** the Habitat Protection Education and Code Revision project was approved for  
16                   funding by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly through adoption of KPB  
17                   Resolution 2009-018; and
