KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2010-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CES TO USE GRANT FUNDS APPROPRIATED IN ORDINANCE 2008-19-06 TO EXPAND THE SIZE OF THE GARAGE AT THE CIECHANSKI WATER SUPPLY SITES

- WHEREAS, in 2008 Central Emergency Services ("CES") received a CCED grant for \$750,000 for the construction of three fire fighting water supply fill points; and
- WHEREAS, the grant authorized including but not limited to installing at three sites 20,000 gallon underground cisterns and provided that the sites would include a generator, in-ground pumps, and a well to provide for the filling of tanks; and
- **WHEREAS**, the grant funds were appropriated in Ordinance 2008-19-06 for the installation of water supply points, and this ordinance increases the authorized scope of use of the funds; and
- WHEREAS, a structure was constructed at the Kasilof site in order to protect the pumps and generator from vandalism; and
- WHEREAS, it would promote public safety and efficiency of fire service to provide a larger garage at the Ciechanski site than provided at Kasilof in order to enable CES to stage structure or wildland fire apparatus closer to densely populated areas and available on-call responders; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Forest Lane fill site construction will be contingent on Assembly approval of the FY2011 capital budget; and
- WHEREAS, there are adequate grant funds remaining to construct the 2 garages without additional appropriation; and
- WHEREAS, the CES board reviewed this proposal at its regularly scheduled meeting of November 13, 2008 and recommended an increase in building size and an additional bay door; and
- WHEREAS, shortened time is requested in order to timely bid and construct the garage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. CES is authorized to use the grant funds appropriated by Ordinance 2008-19-06 for completion of garage approximately 1,152 feet in size at the Ciechanski Water The mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents Supply sites. necessary to effectuate this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
