NUMBER OF PERSONS VOTING IN THIS ELECTION: 3044

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH DECLARES:

1. That James V. Arness received 600 votes and is elected to a 3 year term on the borough assembly having received in excess of 40% of the votes cast for this office.
2. That George Denison and Ron Mika received 330 and 354 votes respectively for a three year assembly seat. As neither candidate received the required 40% (456) necessary to be elected, he shall therefore be a candidate in the runoff election scheduled for October 22, 1974.
3. That O. O. "Bob" Gerbitz and Carl S. Glick received 1024 and 1006 respectively and are elected to three year terms on the school board. Each received in excess of 40% of the votes cast for the office (988).
4. That Bruce A. Bartel and Marie B. Mott received 1651 and 1616 respectively and are elected to two year terms on the school board, having received in excess of 40% (975) of the votes cast for that seat.

5. That Proposition 1 on the North Kenai Fire Service Area ballot received 214 "Yes" votes and 106 "No" votes and is declared approved by the voters of that area.

6. That Proposition 2 on the North Kenai Fire Service Area ballot received 216 "Yes" votes and 107 "No" votes and is declared approved by the voters of that area.


7. That the following candidates received the highest vote for positions on the North Kenai Fire Service AREA Board and are hereby elected:


