RESOLUTION 75-35

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE PRESENTATION OF THE DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX ROLL, AND AUTHORIZATION TO PROCEED TO COLLECTION UPON A SPECIFIED AMOUNT FOR THE DELINQUENT TAXES DUE IN THE YEARS 1969, 1970, 1971, 1972, 1973, and 1974.

WHEREAS, this resolution is necessary pursuant to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances, Section 25.05.110; and

WHEREAS, the tax collector has compiled a roll of persons delinquent in personal property taxes, and the amount owing thereon; and

WHEREAS, said roll has been presented to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly; and

WHEREAS, enforcement of the lien of personal property taxes is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly is to specify the minimum amount due on each account, upon which collection shall be enforced;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:


That the collection of delinquent personal property taxes for the years 1969, 1970, 1971, 1972, 1973, and 1974 be accomplished as provided in Title 25 of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances, which collection shall be for all amounts in excess of

\$35.00 for each year, or any tax account, which shall have accumulated more than \$35.00 total over several years.


That any delinquent tax account of any amount may be joined for suit with any other claim.

That the Borough officers and the Borough attorney's office, be and the same are hereby directed to properly collect such delinquent taxes, by suit, distraint, or other appropriate means.
