RESOLUTION 75-39

A RESOLUTION FOR RETIRING FROM ACTIVE COLLECTION PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEARS 1965, 1966, 1967, AND 1968.

WHEREAS, delinquent personal property taxes for the years 1965, 1966, 1967, and 1968 have been delinquent for more than six years; and

WHEREAS, the personal property taxes delinquent, are in the following amount, 1965-\$118.11; 1966-\$454.00; 1967-\$1,917.86; 1968-\$2,146.60; for a total delinquency in the amount of \$4,636.57, all of which more fully appears in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to AS 09.10.120 the statute of limitation for the bringing of suit is 6 years in the absence of fraud; and

WHEREAS, the administrative offices of the borough should be alert to any accounts upon which enforcement could, and should be undertaken within an exception to the said statute of limitations; Now Therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

That the delinquent personal property taxes for the years 1965, 1966, 1967, and 1968, be and the same are hereby retired from


