RESOLUTION 75-41

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND FOR SPECIFIC PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough has appropriated \$1,300,000 for capital projects fund and has previously authorized expenditures therefrom in the amount of \$100,084, leaving a balance therein of \$1,199,916; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has previously recommended authorization of expenditures on a priority basis totalling \$130,500; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has now further recommended purchasing of carpeting for Kenai Central High School and installation of part or all of it requiring expenditures of \$45,000; and

WHEREAS, authorization of the total amount of such expenditures, amounting to \$175,500, would leave a balance in the capital projects fund of \$1,024,416;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

That the amount of \$175,500 is hereby authorized to be expended from the capital projects fund to accomplish the following capital




improvements:

- (1) Fencing at Anchor Point School, North Kenai Elementary School, and the Head-quarter Site;
- (2) Preparing and seeding athletic field at Seward High School;
- (3) Venting kitchens at Anchor Point School and Tustumena School;
- (4) Venting wood shops at Homer High School, Kenai Junior High School, Kenai Central High School, Ninilchik School, and Soldotna Junior High School;
- (5) Water improvements at Anchor Point School and Bob Bartlett School at Tyonek;
- (6) Installation of storm drain at Sears Elementary School;
- (7) Purchase and installation of carpeting at Kenai Central High School.
