NOW, THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH DECLARES:

- 1. That Donald E. Gilman and Stan Thompson received 1304 and 1834 votes respectively for a three year mayoral term. As neither candidate received the required 50% majority (1988) necessary to be elected, he shall therefore be a candidate in the runoff election scheduled for October 28, 1975.
- 2. That K. Lewis Fields, Paul Fischer, and Patrick M. O'Connell received 776, 850, and 970 votes respectively and are elected to three year terms on the borough assembly having each received in excess of 40% (618) of the votes cast for the office.
- 3. That Carolyn Cannava, Jerry C. Hobart, and Mary E. Shields received 2279, 1572, and 1637 respectively and elected to three year terms on the school board; each having received 40% (1174) of the votes cast for those seats.
- 4. That the following candidates received the highest vote for positions on the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area Board and are hereby elected to three year terms:

- 8. That Proposition B received 886 "Yes" votes and 2917 "No" votes and hereby failed approval by the voters of this election.
- 9. That Proposition 1 received 2634 "Yes" votes and 1334 "No" votes and is declared approved by the voters of this election.
