RESOLUTION 75-56

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO WAIVE PENALTY AND INTEREST ON TAXES DUE NOVEMBER 15, 1975, WHERE LATE PAYMENT IS CAUSED BY STRIKE OF CANADIAN POSTAL EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is aware of the strike of postal employees in Canada; and


WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the assembly that some Canadians have been unable to make payment when due of the second half of real and personal property taxes which were due and payable November 15, 1975, because of said strike;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

That the Mayor of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is hereby authorized to waive penalty and interest on late payments of the second one-half of taxes (due November 15, 1975) where the late payments are shown to be attributable to the strike of postal employees in Canada.
