A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE JANUARY 25, 1977  
SPECIAL BOROUGH BOND ELECTION

WHEREAS, the assembly has received from the Canvassing Board the Kenai Peninsula Borough "Certificates of Results" of the Special Bond Election held on January 25, 1977, and

WHEREAS, the "Certificate of Results" records the following:

PROPOSITION:

Shall Ordinance 76-54 be approved thereby authorizing the Kenai Peninsula Borough to incur indebtedness and to issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$19,819,000 for the purpose of constructing and equipping:

Anchor Point School -	2 classroom addition in the amount of \$389,000
Sterling School -	3 classroom addition in the amount of \$743,000
Tustumena School -	3 classroom addition in the amount of \$680,000
Homer High School -	9 classroom addition in the amount of \$2,007,000
Soldotna High School	in the amount of \$16,000,000

with payment of such indebtedness to be made from taxes levied within the Kenai Peninsula Borough, and from such other revenues as may be properly pledged for such payment, with the full faith and credit of the Kenai Peninsula Borough pledged for the repayment of the indebtedness?


