RESOLUTION 77-46

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA ELECTION OF JULY 12, 1977

WHEREAS, the Assembly has received from the Canvassing Board the "Certificates of Results" of the Special Election in a portion of the Bear Creek Precinct held on July 12, 1977 to approve or disapprove bonding the Bear Creek Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the "Certificate of Results" records the following:

PROPOSITION:

Shall Ordinance 77-33 be approved to authorize the Kenai Peninsula Borough to incur indebtedness and to issue bonds of the borough in an amount not to exceed \$130,000 to be used for the purpose of acquiring a site and constructing and equipping a fire station and related facilities to be located in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, with repayment of such indebtedness to be derived solely from property taxes to be levied within the Bear Creek Fire Service Area?
