PROPOSITION 4

Shall Ordinance 77-51 be approved thereby authorizing the Kenai Peninsula Borough to incur indebtedness and to issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$25,970,000 for the purpose of constructing and equipping:

Anchor Point School - 2 classroom addition  
in the amount of \$450,000  
Sterling School - 3 classroom addition in  
the amount of \$830,000  
Tustumena School - 3 classroom addition in  
the amount of \$755,000  
Homer High School - 9 classroom addition  
in the amount of \$2,150,000  
Soldotna High School in the amount of  
\$18,070,000  
Soldotna Elementary School in the amount of  
\$3,715,000

with payment of such indebtedness to be made from taxes levied within the Kenai Peninsula Borough, and from such other revenues as may be properly pledged for such payment, with the full faith and credit of the Kenai Peninsula Borough pledged for the repayment of the indebtedness?

NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
DECLARES:

1. That James V. Arness and Stan Long received 1179 and 1140 votes respectively and are elected to three year terms on the borough assembly having each received in excess of 40% of the votes cast for those seats.
2. That no candidate for two school board seats received 40% of the votes cast for those seats; therefore the four candidates receiving the highest number of votes, Carl S. Glick, Linda R. O'Brien, Neil Phelps-Munson and Virginia "Ginny" Savoie will be candidates in a runoff election scheduled for October 25, 1977.

3. That the following candidates received the highest number of votes for positions on the South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area Board and are hereby elected to terms as follows:

Seat G, 3 year term - Howard Myhill

4. That the following candidates received the highest number of votes for positions on the Nikiski Fire Service Area Board and are hereby elected to terms as follows:

Seat A, 3 year term - Mary Lee Estes  
Seat B, 3 year term - James A. "Jim" Kurka  
Seat C, 3 year term - Leonard M. Efta

5. That the following candidates received the highest number of votes for positions on the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Board and are hereby elected to terms as follows:

Seat A, 3 year term - Linda L. Wood  
Seat B, 3 year term - Charles D. Blair

6. That the following candidate received the highest number of votes for a position on the Bear Creek Fire Service Area Board and is elected to a three year term:

Seat E, Robert F. Ashley

7. That Proposition 1 received 1644 "Yes" votes and 2740 "No" votes and hereby failed to be approved by the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

8. That Proposition 2 received 1146 "Yes" votes and 3376 "No" votes and hereby failed to be approved by the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

9. That Proposition 3 received 1485 "Yes" votes and 3027 "No" votes and hereby failed to be approved by the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

10. That Proposition 4 received 2603 "Yes" votes and 2006 "No" votes and hereby was approved by the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
