WHEREAS, it is desirable that the citizens of the Borough be as fully informed as possible regarding matters brought before the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the most effective method of informing the citizens of the Borough is through the live broadcastings of all regular Borough Assembly meetings; and

WHEREAS, it is commercially infeasible for radio stations to broadcast the full proceedings of each regular Assembly meetings without contractual assistance from the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires that its meetings be broadcast for a period of four months in order to ascertain whether such broadcasts should be continued;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$7,700 is transferred from the Assembly Contingency Account No. 01-1110-7300 to the Assembly Contract Services Account No. 01-1110-3400 and that this sum shall be utilized to contract with radio stations KRXA (Seward), KQOK (Central Peninsula), and KBBI (South Peninsula), at the rates set forth in the proposals of each respective station, for the broadcasting of all regular Borough Assembly meetings during the months of February, March, April and May, 1981.
