KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-6

PROVIDING FOR A ONE YEAR EXTENSION OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH AND ITS INSURANCE BROKER, ROLLINS, BURDICK & HUNTER OF ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the Borough solicited proposals in 1978 from insurance brokers for the performance of all insurance brokerage and risk assessment needs of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly, by motion at its meeting of May 16, 1978, approved a three year contract between the Borough and Rollins, Burdick & Hunter, by which all Borough insurance policies are placed through Rollins in return for the provision of in-depth insurance and other technical services to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Rollins, Burdick & Hunter has rendered exceptional professional insurance and related technical services to the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance recommends that the Assembly approve the one year continuance of the contract by which the Borough places all of its insurance purchases through Rollins, Burdick & Hunter in return for brokerage and other professional and technical services; and

WHEREAS, the proposed extension of the contract period will not result in any additional cost to the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly approves a one year extension of the agreement between the Borough and Rollins, Burdick & Hunter for the placement of all insurance purchases
