KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-10

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAVING AND
UPGRADING OF CERTAIN ROADS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, arterial roads within the Borough are currently
maintained by the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the majority of these roads serve areas of
significant population density and are in need of frequent
maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that it is desirable to
pave certain arterial roads so as to minimize the need for
frequent maintenance due to high traffic volumes and to
provide better and more convenient access to the lands lying
along these arterial roads;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE
KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly urges the legislature
to appropriate the sum of \$12,500,000 to provide for the
paving and upgrading of arterial roads within the Borough as
follows:

Bear Lake Rd.	Paving	\$ 500,000
Diamond Ridge Rd.	Upgrading & Gravel Maintenance	\$2,677,500
Lamplight Rd.	Paving	\$3,400,00

Section 2. That the Clerk shall serve copies of this resolution upon the Honorable Jay S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Alaska, upon the Honorable Jay Kerttula, President of the State Senate, upon the Honorable Speaker of the State House, upon the Honorable Donald E. Gilman, State Senator, upon the Honorables Bette Cato, Hugh Malone and Pat O'Connell, State Representatives.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
