KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-110

AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE DRILLING OF A BACKUP WELL AT THE NORTH PENINSULA RECREATION SERVICE AREA POOL.

WHEREAS, the existing well at the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Pool went dry and as a result the pool was shut down; and

WHEREAS, the Service Area Board solicited bids for the drilling of a backup well for the pool; and

WHEREAS, Spires Company was the low bidder for the sinking of a well and associated electrical and waterline work; and

WHEREAS, the Service Area Board of Directors at its meeting of June 4, 1981, recommended that a contract with Spires Company for the sinking of a well be approved;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the bid of Spires Company to sink a backup well, and associated electrical and waterline work, at North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Pool for a total cost of \$17,114 is accepted and a contract is awarded. All expenditures shall be charged to Account Number 51-44110-9010.

Section 2. That the sum of \$25,000 is transferred from the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Contingency Account Number 51-44110-9007 to the Backup Well Account Number 51-44110-9010 to provide the contract cost plus an amount for contingency.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
