RESOLUTION 81-116

APPROVING THE BOROUGH SCHOOL BOARD'S SELECTION OF W.J. WELLENSTEIN, ARCHITECT FOR PROPOSED PROJECTS AT NORTH KENAI ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITIONS.

WHEREAS, the School Board is charged by Alaska Statute 14.14.060(e) with setting design criteria for school buildings and with selecting the architect to develop these designs, subject to the approval of the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the School Board recommended the selection of W.J. Wellenstein as architect for the proposed North Kenai Elementary School Addition; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly concurs with the School Board's selection of W.J. Wellenstein for these projects;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the School Board's June 2, 1981, selection of W.J. Wellenstein as architect for the proposed construction of the North Kenai Elementary School Addition is approved. The obligation of any funds for these projects shall be contingent upon appropriation of necessary funds by the Assembly and upon the negotiation and execution of a contract for concept development and schematic design phases of each project.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
