KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-12 (REVISED)

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO THE BOROUGH LOCAL SERVICE ROADS AND TRAILS ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, the Assembly, by Resolution 79-22, identified priority Local Service Roads and Trails construction projects within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, certain projects could not be constructed due to financial limitations; and

WHEREAS, the need for these projects remains and the cost of these and other projects is estimated to total approximately \$2,520,000 of which the Borough has received only \$447,000; and

WHEREAS, the current legislation providing for the Local Service Roads and Trails program provides only for funding of this program through periodic bond issues, and the Assembly finds that the direct appropriation of state funds, in addition to bond proceeds, would best serve the interest of the citizens of this state and that this appropriation should be made without regard to funds provided separately to any other borough or city;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly urges the Twelfth Legislature, First Session, to amend the Local Service Roads and Trails enabling statute, AS19.30.111 et seq, to provide for the direct appropriation of general state funds to Local Service Roads and Trails projects in addition to the allocation of bond fund proceeds, and to provide further that the funds requested by this Resolution shall be allocated to the Borough's own construction account without regard to the funds, if any, allocated to any other borough or city.

Section 2. That the Assembly requests the legislature to appropriate the lump sum of \$2,073,000 to the Borough's Local Service Roads and Trails account to be utilized in constructing the following projects:

Gilman, State Senator, and upon The Honorables Bette Cato, Hugh Malone and Pat O'Connell, State Representatives.
