KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-121

URGING THE STATE OF ALASKA TO ESTABLISH A STATION IN THE KENAI-NORTH KENAI AREAS FOR THE GRANTING OF TRUCK OVERWEIGHT AND OVERWIDTH PERMITS.

WHEREAS, more than 50% of the Kenai Peninsula's industrial and commercial trucking traffic operates in the Kenai-North Kenai area; and

WHEREAS, truckers operating in the Kenai-North Kenai area frequently move items which are in excess of the allowed truck weight or width limits and these overweight or overwidth loads require the issuance of a special permit; and

WHEREAS, all such overweight or overwidth permits are now issued through State offices located in the City of Soldotna requiring truckers in the Kenai-North Kenai area to apply for a permit in person at Soldotna and this is time-consuming and expensive; and

WHEREAS, overweight and overwidth permits are already issued in the Homer and Seward areas through branch offices established by the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, state office facilities and personnel capable of issuing these permits are already located in the Kenai-North Kenai area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly urges the State of Alaska, Department of Public Safety, to establish a station in the Kenai-North Kenai area for the issuance of overweight and overwidth permits in the same manner as they are now issued in the Homer and Seward area.

Section 2. That the Clerk shall serve a copy of this resolution upon the Honorable William R. Nix, Commissioner of Department of Public Safety, and shall request the courtesy of a prompt response regarding the matters set forth in this resolution.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
