KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-127

PROVIDING FOR THE ALLOCATION OF STATE PER CAPITA AIDE TO MUNICIPALITIES.

WHEREAS, the Twelfth Legislature, First Session, has provided for a grant of state funds to municipalities on a per capita basis, such funds to be used for necessary capital improvement projects and other uses; and

WHEREAS, the Borough will receive funds on the basis of 13,704 people residing within that portion of the Borough outside any first class city; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires that these funds be allocated in a fair and equitable manner among the various eligible areas of the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That any funds received from the State of Alaska on a per capita basis pursuant to Senate Bill No. 168 as enacted shall be allocated and expended for capital improvement projects and other necessary uses within that portion of each assembly district outside of any first class city in accordance with this formula:

Funds allocated for the eligible area of each assembly district shall bear the same proportion to the total funds appropriated to the Borough by the State of Alaska on a per capita basis that the population of that portion of an assembly district lying outside of any first class city bears to the total population of the Borough lying outside of any first class city.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
