RESOLUTION 81-138

SUPPORTING THE SELECTION OF THE KENAI-SOLDOTNA AREA AS THE SITE OF THE STATE JUNIOR MISS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, America's Junior Miss organization is presently considering the selection of a site for the 1982 Junior Miss Program; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai-Soldotna community has enthusiastically provided community support for this program; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai-Soldotna area contains adequate facilities and services necessary to support and produce the Junior Miss Program, and possesses adequate auditorium facilities and transportation routes; and

WHEREAS, the Junior Miss Program is a wholesome, creative, and constructive enterprise and activity for the junior misses of the Kenai-Soldotna area which offers an opportunity for personal betterment and achievement with the rewards of scholarships at several of the well established post secondary educational institutions in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai-Soldotna area would welcome its selection as the permanent site of the Junior Miss Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly wholeheartedly supports and encourages the selection of the Kenai-Soldotna area as the site of the 1982 Alaska Junior Miss Program, and records its enthusiastic support for selection of the Kenai-Soldotna area as the permanent site of the Junior Miss Program in Alaska.

Section 2. This resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be served upon America's Junior Miss, Inc., P. O. Box 2786, Mobile, Alabama 36652.
