RESOLUTION 81-140

INCREASING THE HOURLY WAGE PAID TO PERMANENT PART-TIME
LIFEGUARDS AT THE NORTH KENAI POOL.

WHEREAS, permanent part-time lifeguards at the North Kenai Recreation Service Area Pool are currently paid \$6.05 per hour and the average salary for similar positions at other pools is \$7.05 per hour; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the service area, at their regular meeting of July 28, 1981, unanimously recommended that the Assembly raise the hourly rate for permanent part-time lifeguards to \$7.10 per hour in order to maintain comparability with lifeguards employed at other pools in comparable positions; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has adopted a rate of pay for these positions from time to time by resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the rate of pay for permanent part-time lifeguards employed at the North Kenai Recreation Service Area Pool shall be \$7.10 per hour.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the date following its adoption.
