RESOLUTION 81-142

APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR THE PREPARATION OF SCHEMATIC DRAWINGS FOR THE ANCHOR POINT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION AND APPROVING HAROLD WIRUM & ASSOCIATES AS ARCHITECTS.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District Board of Education has determined that a library classroom addition to the Anchor Point Elementary School is a priority capital improvement project to be included in the bond issues presented to the voters at the regular election of October 6, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly approves the selection of Harold Wirum & Associates as architects to prepare the design for this project; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that preliminary design work for the Anchor Point Elementary School Addition begin at the earliest possible time in order to expedite the preparation of schematic designs for this project and to arrive at a firm cost estimate for the project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Assembly transfer sufficient funds to the Architects and Engineers Fee Account for this project; and

WHEREAS, surplus contingency funds are assigned to the Nikolaevsk School Project Account No. 62-13681-9007;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$21,000 is transferred from the Nikolaevsk School Contingency Account No. 62-13681-9007 to the Anchor Point Elementary School Addition Contingency Account No. 62-10182-9007.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with Harold Wirum & Associates as architects to perform all work required for the preparation of schematic documents on a time and materials basis not to exceed \$17,000.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
