KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-145

DECLARING THE COOPER LANDING MULTI-USE ADDITION TO BE A PRIORITY CAPITAL PROJECT AND REQUESTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO SELECT AN ARCHITECT.

WHEREAS, the space previously used for multi-use recreation is needed as a classroom; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly has determined the addition of a multi-use space to be a priority need; and

WHEREAS, an architect should be selected at the earliest possible time to expedite the preparation of schematic designs for this project and to arrive at a firm cost estimate for the project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly considers the Cooper Landing Multi-Use Addition to be a priority capital project.

Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Board of Education is urged to select an architect to do the preliminary planning in order to expedite the project and arrive at a firm cost estimate.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
