KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-151

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$9,436 FOR THE REPAIR OF TANKER
#2 OF THE NIKISKI FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Nikiski Fire Department operates a 2,400
gallon tanker truck as a first line unit; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle has experienced significant mainten-
ance problems because of the previous failure of the standard
transmission for this truck; and

WHEREAS, a transmission is again in need of replacement or
repair and these maintenance problems will be eliminated
through replacement of the standard transmission with a
four-speed automatic transmission; and

WHEREAS, Emerson G.M. Diesel is the sole source for the
supply and installation of the Allison automatic transmission
required by the vehicle warranty and has proposed to do all
work necessary to supply and install the Allison automatic
transmission for the amount of \$9,436; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the standard transmission will
enhance the Nikiski Fire Department's ability to respond to
fires within its service area and to protect the public safety;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal by Emerson G.M. Diesel to
replace a standard transmission on a 1978 L-800 tanker unit
with a four-speed Allison automatic transmission for the sum of
\$9,436 is accepted and a contract is awarded. All expenditures
for this project shall be charged to the Nikiski Fire Service
Area Account #20-43110-2800.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate
this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its
adoption.
