RESOLUTION 81-155

ENDORISING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE KENAI BRANCH OFFICE OF THE COOK INLET NATIVE ASSOCIATION IN MAKING PUBLIC SERVICE AND YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAMS AVAILABLE TO RESIDENTS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA AREA.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Branch Office of the Cook Inlet Native Association (Kenai-Cook Inlet) opened in June of 1978; and

WHEREAS, in January of 1979 the scope of operations was expanded to include full service job training programs; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai-Cook Inlet program has been the only employment and training contractor for communities of the Kenai Peninsula area; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai branch office provides a worthwhile social service totally dedicated to community improvement through the employment skills training of individuals who can take up gainful employment and become achievers in the community;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That the Assembly endorses the activities of the Kenai branch office of the Cook Inlet Native Association (Kenai-Cook Inlet) in providing full service job training programs for communities of the Kenai Peninsula area, and urges the State of Alaska to provide adequate funds in the current budget year to ensure that this worthwhile social service will continue to be available to the persons seeking to develop and improve individual employment skills.

Section 2: That the Clerk shall serve copies of this resolution upon the Honorable Jay S. Hammond, Governor of Alaska, upon the Honorable Terry Miller, Lieutenant Governor of Alaska and upon the Honorables Bette Cato, Hugh Malone and Pat O'Connell, State Representatives.
