KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-156

AWARDING A CONTRACT TO TRANS-ALASKA ENGINEERING FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SUPERVISION OF A SOLID WASTE BALING FACILITY AT THE HOMER LANDFILL.

WHEREAS, the construction of a solid waste baling facility at the Homer Landfill is a priority capital improvement project and will allow the Borough to significantly lower the cost of providing solid waste disposal in the Homer area; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for design and construction of the baling facility is \$1,000,000, to be financed from a grant to the Borough from the Department of Environmental Conservation of \$500,000, with an additional \$500,000 to be appropriated from state municipal assistance monies; and

WHEREAS, the Borough solicited proposals from qualified consultants to design and provide construction supervision services for the baling facility; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has reviewed the submitted proposals and has recommended that the Assembly accept the proposal of Trans-Alaska Engineering to perform all design work for a cost not to exceed \$95,000 and to provide construction supervision services for a cost not to exceed \$80,000, for a total cost of \$175,000, and sufficient funds are available;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of Trans-Alaska Engineering to design a solid waste baling facility for the Homer Landfill and to provide construction supervision services of this project, for a total cost not to exceed \$175,000, is accepted and a contract is awarded. All expenditures for this contract shall be charged to the Solid Waste Account No. 63-27481-9215.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
