RESOLUTION 81-158

APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A NEW GENERATOR FOR THE MOOSE PASS SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, the existing generator at the Moose Pass School is approximately 30 years old and is in poor condition; and

WHEREAS, the existing emergency generator constitutes a fire hazard because of its poor condition and because of burned out controls; and

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Department has solicited proposals for a Kohler GOH2-50KW 120/240 single phase generator; and

WHEREAS, the low proposal was submitted by Industry Service, Inc., for purchase of the generator at a price of \$11,400, and sufficient funds are available;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of Industry Service, Inc., to supply a Kohler GOH2-50KW 120/240 single phase generator for a price of \$11,400, is accepted and a contract is awarded. All expenditures for this purchase shall be charged to Account No. 61-14582-9007.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
