AWARDING A CONTRACT TO MALONE SURVEYING TO CONDUCT PRELIMINARY SURVEY WORK FOR THE MYERS/STRAWBERRY ROAD PROJECT AND FOR THE BIG EDDY ROAD PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires to provide for the upgrading of Myers/Strawberry Road and of Big Eddy Road as priority projects; and

WHEREAS, the Borough cannot proceed with design of these projects until the proposed road alighnments have been surveyed; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Malone Surveying has proposed to perform all necessary survey and mapping work for the Myers/Strawberry Road Project for an amount not to exceed \$10,500 and for the Big Eddy Road Project for an amount not to exceed \$11,250; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has examined the proposal and recommends the award of a contract to Malone Surveying to perform this survey work; and

WHEREAS, the survey work accomplished under this contract will be incorporated into the final design of these roads;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of Malone Surveying to perform preliminary survey work for the Myers/Strawberry Road Project in an amount not to exceed \$10,500, and for the Big Eddy Road Project in an amount not to exceed \$11,250, is accepted and a contract is awarded. All expenditures for the Myers/Strawberry Road Project shall be charged to Account No. 65-21040-9007 and all expenditures for the Big Eddy Road Project shall be charged to Account No. 65-21044-9007.

Section 2. That the sum of \$20,000 is transferred from the Road Design Contingency Account No. 65-21001-9007 to the Myers/Strawberry Road Account No. 65-21040-9007 and that the sum of \$20,000 is transferred from the Road Design Contingency Account No. 65-21001-9007 to the Big Eddy Road Contingency Account No. 65-21044-9007.
